I graduated from The Robert Gordon University, Aberdeen in July 2008 with a BA (Hons) in Accounting and Finance. During my third year I was fortunate to secure a placement with EQ in their Forfar office. The placement was a requirement of the degree course I undertook.

The placement was designed to widen my knowledge and expertise in the field of accountancy whilst also giving a further insight into accountancy in practice and the various other areas involved.

During my placement I participated in a wide variety of work. I assisted in the preparation of both accounts and tax returns and this gave me an excellent grounding for my final year studies.
